

Travel instructions for visiting the Centre for Sustainable Energy Systems at the Australian National University in Canberra

The Centre for Sustainable Energy Systems is located in the east wing of Engineering Building 32 at Grid Reference F4 (bottom right corner of F4) on the ANU map found at <http://campusmap.anu.edu.au/>

A more detailed map of our location is attached below.

1. Turn west into Barry Drive at the traffic lights on Northbourne Avenue, near the centre of the city. There is a large sign pointing to the Australian National University.
 - a. From Sydney, drive into Canberra along the Federal Highway and turn right at Barry Drive.
 - b. From south Canberra, drive over Commonwealth Ave. Bridge and turn left at Barry Drive.
 - c. From the airport, drive along Parkes Way and Constitution Avenue to the city, and then along London Circuit and turn north into Northbourne Avenue and left into Barry Drive.
2. Travel west along Barry Drive for about 1km, past ovals on both left and right, and turn left into North Road at the traffic lights. There is a large sign pointing to the Australian National University.
3. Follow North Road for 100m past the tennis courts, and bear left at the intersection. Continue on for 200m to the Sports Union precinct. The Engineering precinct is on your right. Turn right into the Engineering carpark. There are 3 car park spaces marked as “FEIT Visitor Parking”. Your host will normally meet you in this carpark.

You will need a visitor pass, which will either be provided by your host or can be obtained from the Faculty Office (inside the Ian Ross Building 31 in front of the car park; up the stairs to reception).

There is additional pay-parking to the south of the Engineering Building.
